



Other Points to Consider

- No other exam will count towards the program.
- No discounts are offered on sick patient visits or emergency visits. The only discounts are listed in the brochure.
- The 2023 enrollment fee of **\$175** is non-refundable and not transferable. If your pet dies or is lost, it cannot be transferred to a new pet. Likewise, if you re-home your pet, it is not transferable to the new owner.
- Wellness visits at any other veterinary clinic do not fulfill the requirement to stay enrolled in the Free Vaccinations for Life Program.



How much can I save?

Under most circumstances, your enrollment in Free Vaccinations For Life will pay for itself within three visits.

When can I sign my pet up?

You can sign them up at any time. Our team will be sure to enroll your pet(s) once we receive the contract and payment. You can fill out at the office or fill out all the paperwork on our website if that works better for you.

Will I receive reminders when the vaccinations are due and for the annual exam?

Yes, you will receive reminders. However, it is important to also keep track of when the vaccinations and examinations are due. You can always request a reminder summary for each patient.

Can we use any other offers or promotions with the program?

Unfortunately, this program cannot be combined with any other offers or practice promotions.

How can we pay the enrollment fee?

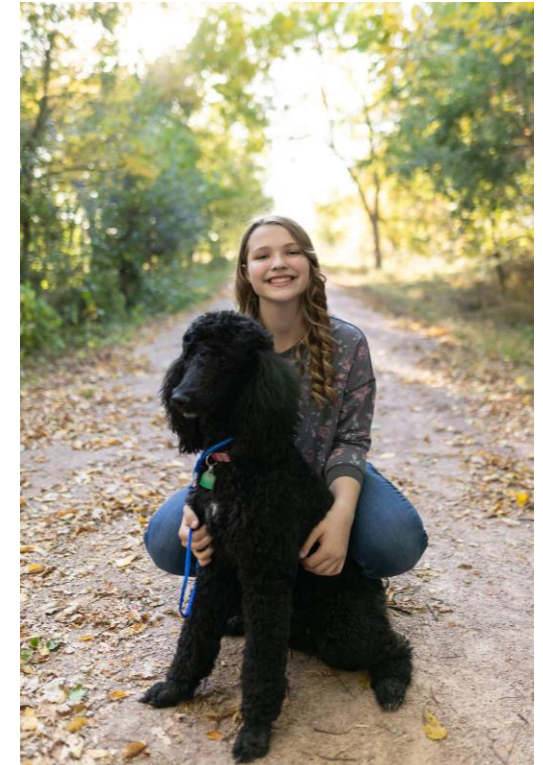

What is it?

Free Vaccinations for Life (FVFL) is a program offered by Willow Creek Veterinary Services and Westside Family Pet Clinic. After enrolling, your pet will get our core vaccines for free and our other recommended vaccines at a deep discount. That's a huge lifetime savings!!!!

This program lasts as long as you have your pet and as long as your pet gets an annual Wellness Care Visit at either clinic.

Why?

Vaccinations are only one part of maintaining the health of your pet. At our clinics, we are passionate about preventative care and we want to help our clients afford the other details that are important too. Regular Wellness Care Visits, annual dental cleanings, and routine laboratory work are key to early disease detection and successful treatment outcomes.

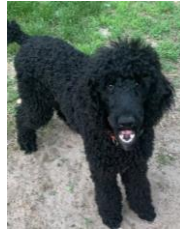
What else does enrollment get you?

Membership will get you other discounts!!

-You get 10% off Feline TripleTest

-10% off your pet's spay or neuter surgery

-10% off of a yearly dental cleaning



The 2023 enrollment fee of \$175 seems expensive at first, but when you figure it out, most pets will have the program paid for within 2 to 3 years. The program will save you approximately \$55 per year to use toward other preventative services for your pet like dental work and laboratory tests.

What's the Catch?

1. Your pet must be seen for an annually Wellness Care Visit in a timely manner. If your pet is more than one calendar month late for the Wellness Care Visit, you are no longer enrolled in the program. Sick visits do not count as a Wellness Care Visit. If more than 13 months have passed since the last Wellness Care Visit, vaccines will be charged at full price or the pet may be enrolled again.
2. The enrollment fee of \$175 will need to be paid.

Dog Program

- Wellness Exam – required for program, charges will apply yearly
- Rabies – every 2 years – included with the program
- DA2PP – every 2 years – included with the program
- Leptosporosis – yearly – included with the program at ½ price
- Bordetella – yearly – included with program at ½ price

Cat Program

- Wellness Exam – required for program, charges will apply yearly
- Rabies – every 2 years – included with program
- HCPCH – every 2 years – included with program
- Leukemia – yearly – included with the program at ½ price
